Arrangements for obtaining the views of students and staff

The Instrument & Articles of Government require the publication of arrangements for consulting with students and staff at the College on the determination and periodic review of the educational character and mission of the College and the oversight of its activities.

The College uses a range of methods to consult students and staff and obtain their views and feedback. Ways to improve obtaining feedback are continuously sought and the current arrangements to obtain student and staff views are below:

The views of students and staff feed directly into the College's quality assurance processes, including the self-assessment report and Quality Improvement Action Plan which are regularly monitored by the Board of Corporation.

Role of the Board of Corporation/Staff and Student Governors

The Board receive feedback directly through Staff and Student Governors, staff surveys and student survey feedback. Staff and student governors are elected to the Corporation and play a full and equal part in the business of the Corporation and its committees.
