



STUDENT FINANCIAL SUPPORT

A bursary is a government scheme set up to help people facing financial hardship stay in education.

ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for a bursary, you must:

- Be enrolled on an eligible course* for this academic year
- Be in receipt of an approved means tested benefit, or have a household income below £30,000 - *Evidence to support this would need to be uploaded within your application*

Funding is based on individual eligibility and funding rules apply.

*Apprenticeships, work-based learning and full-cost programmes are not eligible for this bursary scheme.

- Travel expenses
- Childcare costs
- Free College Meals
- Tuition fee support
- Course related trips
