Assessments / Exams

There are no exams on this course. You will be assessed via written assignments.

A typical week

Entry requirements

To study on the full-time course you'll need a GCSE grade 1/2 in English and maths.

You can join the part-time course if you have Functional Skills level 1 in English.

Links with employers

50 hours of placement time must be completed as part of the course.

For adult learners, completing this course means you can progress to the Level 2 in Adult Care qualification.
