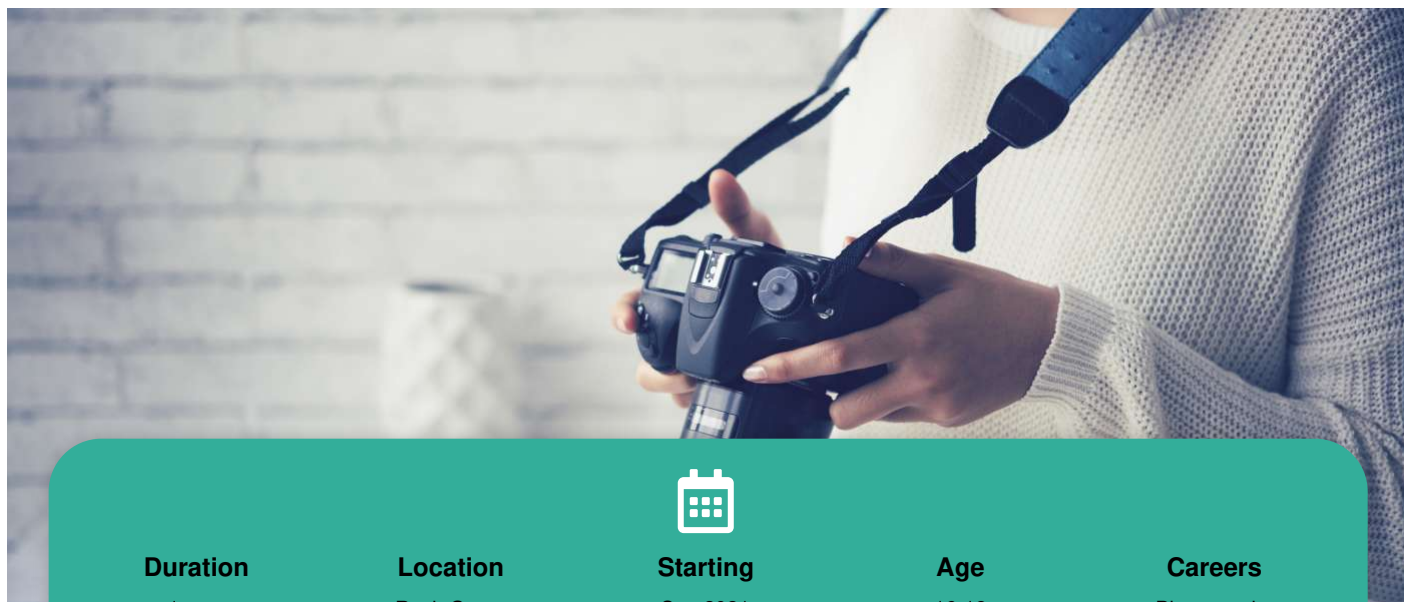

Overview

This is a modern, contemporary photography programme providing you with the skills and knowledge to work in the global creative industries, in particular photography and moving image.

What you'll learn

Over 4 units you will develop your creative potential through practical projects, gain an understanding of how the industry works, and prepare you for higher education and/or work.

Taught by experienced photographers working in the industry, you will learn the relevant skills to work in the exciting world of photography. The course will provide you with additional skills required to work in this industry including business awareness, portfolio building, work experience opportunities, and the ability to be resilient as a creative in a fast-moving global industry.

Assessments / Exams

The course is a 100% coursework and regular assessments are carried out by your course team. Tutorials take place throughout the year. There are no formal examinations on this course.

A typical week

You will use the latest state-of-the-art equipment, including:

- Photography studios
- C41 colour film processing
- B&W Film Processing and Darkrooms
- Colour Darkrooms
- Post-Production Suites
- Analogue and Digital cameras.

Collaboration with students on other programmes and with external creatives to enhance your networking and creative skills is also a key part of the course.

Entry requirements

You will have achieved 4 or more GCSE grades at 4 and above including either English or Maths, or have successfully completed an appropriate Level 2 qualification.

You will also need to provide a portfolio of work, as well as a reference.

Links with employers

The department has excellent links and networks in the photography, moving image, art and fashion industries and these are brought into the curriculum through visits, guest lectures, collaboration and work-experience opportunities.

What this course leads to

On completion of this course, you will be able to progress into our higher education programme in Photography & Moving Image at Barking & Dagenham College, or another at an alternative university.
