

## Overview

This course is great for students wanting to progress into the graphic design industry and other related industries.

## What you'll learn

The breadth of optional content in this qualification allows learners to widen their opportunities to progress to several different higher education courses.

Core Units include:

- **Exploring and Developing Creative Media Skills:** includes an exploration of the fundamentals of creative media practice from a graphic design perspective developing practical skills. You also undertake a graphic design project combining all your skills developed whilst taking this course.
- **Advanced Creative Practice:** includes Personal progression which will help you to develop your understanding of

industry, employment roles and higher education routes within the graphic design industry and creative pathways. You will also develop skills in creating a graphic design proposal for a response to an industry relevant brief.

Whilst on this course you will develop skills in problem solving, technical skills, professional practice, communication and the ability to be able to inform ideas.

## Assessments / Exams

You will complete practical assignments and develop your theory, skills and knowledge 100% internally assessed and through a portfolio of work.

## A typical week

Three days a week on campus working in a designated film studio and classrooms on site with some online learning.

## Entry requirements

4 GCSEs at grade 4 or above including English and Maths.
