

Overview

If you're looking for a career in the construction industry, this course is for you.

You'll develop a broad knowledge and understanding of construction, including health & safety, measuring techniques, data management, digital engineering and design systems and processes. This knowledge will be invaluable to any career in the construction industry.

You'll then be given the option to specialise in carpentry and joinery to build your knowledge, understanding, skills and experience in this area.

As with any T Level, you'll learn through a mix of specialist teaching, and a minimum of 9 weeks working with an employer on a relevant industry placement.

What you'll learn

The core construction learning on this course will cover:

- health and safety
- the science behind building design, surveying and planning
- making accurate and appropriate measurements
- construction methods
- building regulations and standards
- data management and information standards in construction
- relationship management and customer service
- how the Internet of Things (IoT) impacts construction
- digital engineering techniques
- mathematical techniques to solve construction problems
- construction design principles and processes
- the construction industry and its role in the economy
- sustainability and the environmental impact of construction
- business, commerce and corporate social responsibility

You will then specialise in carpentry and joinery.

Assessments / Exams

This course will be assessed through a mix of practical tasks to demonstrate understanding, and written assignments and reports.

Entry requirements

You'll need to have GCSE English Language and Maths at grade 4 or above; and at least three other GCSE qualifications at grade 4 or above **OR** equivalent vocational qualification in a related discipline at level 2 with a minimum Merit grade.

What this course leads to

This course is suitable for anyone wanting a career in construction, specifically in bricklaying, carpentry and joinery, plastering or painting and decorating. Students can progress into roles such as Carpenter, Shopfitter, Bricklayer or Plasterer.
