

Assessments / Exams

Entry requirements

This course is for school leavers and adult students.

16-18: You will need to have GCSEs in English, Maths, Science and one other subject at Grade 4 or above.

Adult 19+: You will need to have a minimum of Level 1 in English and Maths.

What this course leads to

On successful completion of this course, you will be able to go on to study at Level 3. Adults 19+ will need to also complete year 2 of the programme to gain the full qualification.
