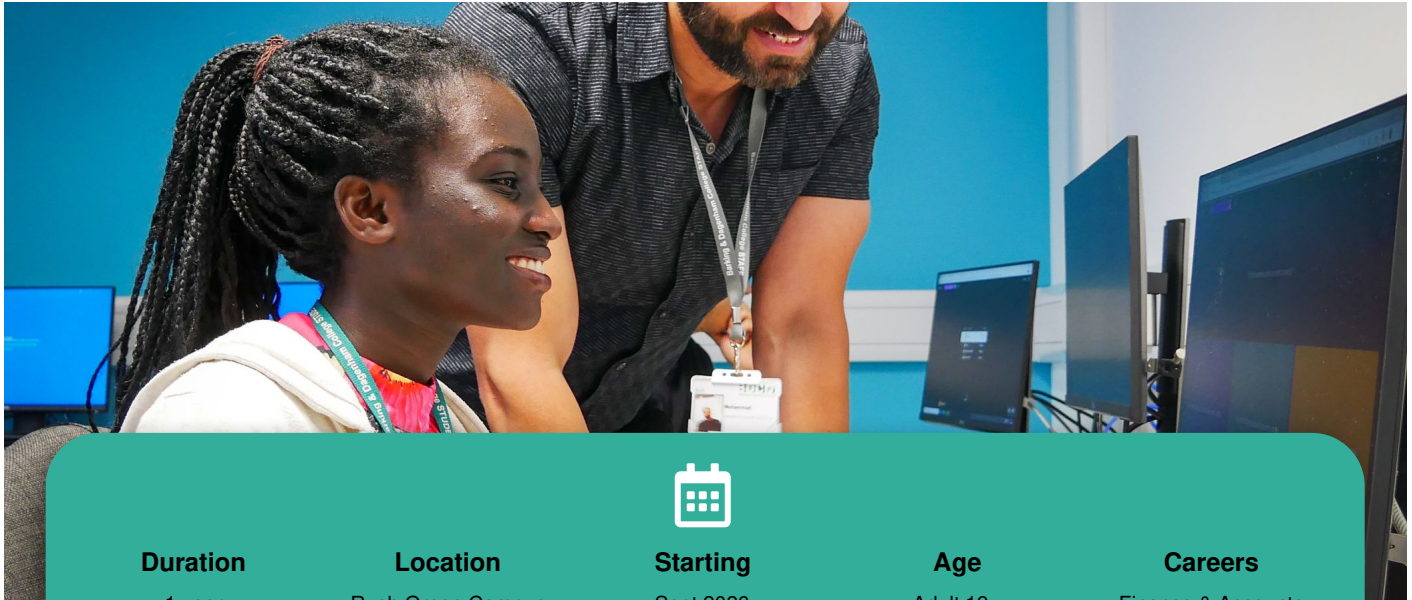

Course fees per year

This course is free for learners aged 16-18. Tuition fees for adult learners are from £1,200 - £1,840. However, if you're an adult learner and don't hold a Level 3 qualification already, then you could be eligible to study this course for free under the National Skills Fund.

The above fees include tuition and exam fees.

You will need to have completed AAT Level 2 Certificate in Accounting with a MERIT to start this course. You will also need basic IT skills.
