Overview

Courses are flexible to fit around your needs.

We offer learning at the <u>Rush Green campus</u> and <u>Barking Learning Centre</u>; during mornings, afternoons and evenings; and between different study modes.

Courses start throughout the year: September, December and March.

ESOL courses are offered from pre-entry Level to Level 2. If you'd like to study an ESOL course, apply on this page and we'll arrange for an initial skills check to make sure you're studying on the right course and the next available start date.

What you'll learn

ESOL courses are aimed at improving your speaking, listening, reading and writing skills. You can also expect to improve your vocabulary, fluency, accuracy and pronunciation.
