

Overview

The AAT Professional Diploma in Accounting is a great choice if you're already working in an accounting role and are looking to progress your career, or have completed the AAT Level 3 and want to study at a higher level.

In this unit you'll learn to consider the role and responsibilities of the accounting function, including the needs of key stakeholders who use financial reports to make decisions. You will learn to review accounting systems to identify weaknesses and will make recommendations for future operations. As well as learning how to identify appropriate controls, assess their impact in terms of cost-effectiveness, reliability and timeliness, and ensure that all functions adapt their working practices to meet new requirements in an ethical and sustainable way.

This module can be studied in isolation to build your knowledge in this specific area, or studied alongside other AAT accredited modules, to lead to an AAT Professional Diploma in Accounting.



What you'll learn

This unit provides students with the fundamental knowledge of the three most common taxes that affect taxpayers in the United Kingdom (UK): income tax, capital gains tax and inheritance tax.

By the end of this module you'll be able to:

- Understand the role and responsibilities of the accounting function within an organisation
- Evaluate internal control systems
- Evaluate an organisation's accounting system and underpinning procedures
- Understand the impact of technology on accounting systems
- Recommend improvements to an organisation's accounting system

You'll need to have GCSE Grade 4 and above in both English Language and Mathematics, or equivalent and you will also need to have completed the AAT Advanced Diploma in Accounting at Level 3 to study on this programme.
