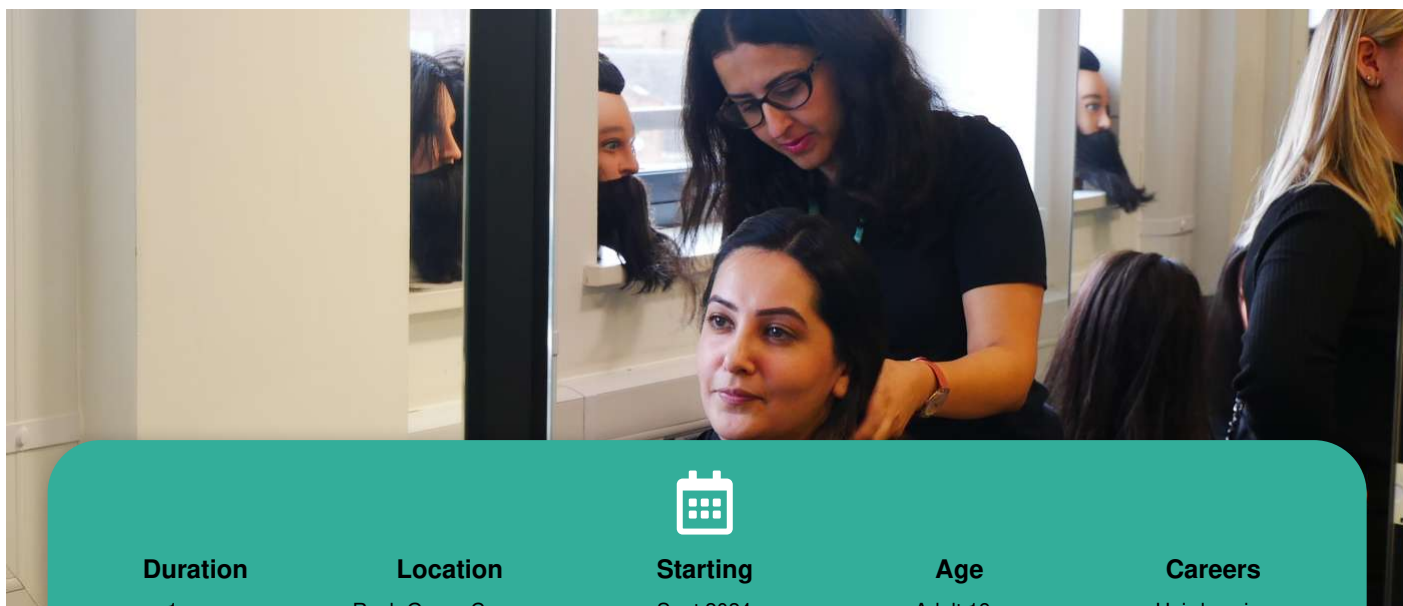

## Overview

This Level 1 course will provide you with the skills and knowledge to develop as a trainee stylist. You will learn the basic hairdressing skills such as Shampoo and Conditioning and Hair styling.

It is ideal if you're just starting out in hair and beauty and want an understanding of the industry - enough to succeed in a job in the area as a junior or to move on to further study, such as a level 2 Hair or Beauty qualification.

## What you'll learn

Within this course you will start to develop your skills as a trainee hairdresser and you will learn skills in Shampoo and conditioning and hair styling. You will also be given opportunity to experience the commercial Salon gaining valuable skills and experience.

The units for this course include:

- Prepare for hair services and maintain work area
