- Operational Procedures: Follow best practices for safety, environmental impacts, and communication and professionalism.

Assessments / Exams

To achieve the CompTIA A+ certification, you are required to register and complete the CompTIA A+ Exam.

The exam will test your knowledge of operating systems, data, security, networking, hardware, and help desk services.

A typical week
