

Overview

Gain a broad range of industry sector skills with this one-year IT study programme, aimed at students who are considering a career in the IT or digital industry sectors.

This course is a practical work-related course. You will learn by completing projects and assignments that are based on realistic workplace situations, activities and demands.

What you'll learn

During this course, you will study ten units in total. Four core units which provide a general foundation and a further six specialist units which introduce you to particular topics in more depth.

- Being Organised
- Developing a Personal Progression Plan
- Working with Others
- Researching a Topic

- Using Digital Communication Technologies
- Solving Technical IT Problems
- Creating a Website

Alongside your main programme of study, you will also study either GCSE or Functional Skills in English and Maths if you have not achieved a GCSE grade 4 or above.

Assessments / Exams

The Level 1 Diploma has units that are assessed through assignment work. Each unit is graded Pass, Merit or Distinction. You will then be awarded an overall grade of Pass, Merit, Distinction or Distinction* on completion of the course.

Entry requirements

You will need to have GCSE Maths, English Language and two additional subjects at grade 2 (E) or above.

As part of the application process you will also be asked to explain why you want to study this course, so that we can ensure any course offer made aligns to your career goals.
